We have had quite a summer. Our two camps went very well. It is very difficult to have them a week apart from the administrative side but the camps themselves were very inspirational and the youth and children were well cared for. Thanks for your prayers and gifts to make the youth mission trip possible. It was one of the best mission experiences I have ever been privileged to be part of.
